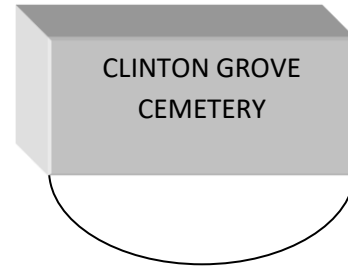


Clinton Grove Cemetery

Decoration Rules

PLANTING AT MONUMENTS AND MARKERS MAY BE MADE IN A SEMI-CIRCLE MEASURING 14 INCHES AS ILLUSTRATED ON THE RIGHT



NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS ARE ALLOWED BETWEEN APRIL 15TH AND NOVEMBER 1ST .

PLANTINGS ARE ALLOWED ON GRAVES WITH MARKERS

PLANTING OF SHRUBS, BUSHES, OR ROSES MUST BE OF THE DWARF OR MINIATURE VARIETIES ONLY, AND WITH PRIOR APPROVAL OF CLINTON GROVE CEMETERY

NO VINES OR CREEPING GROUNDCOVERS OF ANY TYPE MAY BE PLANTED

URNS OR PLANTERS MUST BE PLACED IN-LINE AND NEXT TO MONUMENT OR MARKERS

FRESH FLOWERS ARE PERMITTED ANYTIME IN APPROVED ABOVE GROUND VASE.

BENCHES CAN BE PLACED AT THE FOOT IF CONSTRUCTED OF GRANITE OR MARBLE. CONCRETE BENCHES OF A HISTORIC NATURE HAVE BEEN GRANDFATHERED TO STAY.

ALL STATUES MUST BE UNDER 12 INCHES TALL AND PLACED IN LINE WITH THE MARKER

ALL BALLOONS ARE PROHIBITED

GLASS JARS OR METAL CANS ARE PROHIBITED

NO PLASTIC ORNAMENTS OR PINWHEELS OF ANY TYPE MAY BE PLACED IN CEMETERY

WINTER DECORATIONS MAY BE PLACED AFTER NOVEMBER 15 WITH THE PURCHASE OF A REMOVAL TAG, UNLESS YOU PLAN TO REMOVE DECORATION YOURSELF BY MARCH 15

WINTER DECORATIONS WILL BE REMOVED BY MARCH 15 WEATHER PERMITTING

DO NOT RAISE OR MOUND GRAVES

SHEPHERDS HOOKS, METAL POSTS, METAL DECORATIONS, CURBING OF ANY TYPE, FENCES, BRICKS, STONES, OR MULCH ARE PROHIBITED

ALL PROHIBITED ITEMS AND UNSIGHTLY FLOWERS AND PLANTINGS WILL BE REMOVED

THE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION WILL NOT ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEFT OR BREAKAGE OF ITEMS PLACED AT GRAVESITE, OR FOR VANDALISM TO MONUMENTS, MARKERS OR URNS.
