
Clinton Grove Cemetery

Decoration Rules

PLANTING AT MONUMENTS AND MARKERS MAY
BE MADE IN A SEMI-CIRCLE MEASURING 14 INCHES
AS ILLUSTRATED ON THE RIGHT



NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS ARE ALLOWED BETWEEN APRIL 15TH AND NOVEMBER 1ST.

ALL GLASS, PLASTIC, AND METAL DECORATIONS ARE PROHIBITED

PLANTINGS ARE ALLOWED ON GRAVES WITH MARKERS

PLANTING OF SHRUBS, BUSHES, OR ROSES MUST HAVE PRIOR APPROVAL BY CLINTON GROVE CEMETERY

NO VINES OR CREEPING GROUNDCOVERS OF ANY TYPE MAY BE PLANTED

URNS OR PLANTERS MUST BE PLACED IN-LINE AND NEXT TO MONUMENT OR MARKERS

BENCHES CAN BE PLACED AT THE FOOT OF SPACE WITH PRIOR APPROVAL IF CONSTRUCTED OF GRANITE OR MARBLE

ALL STATUES MUST BE UNDER 24 INCHES TALL AND PLACED IN LINE WITH MARKER

SOLAR LIGHTS ARE PROHIBITED

NO PINWHEELS OR BALLOONS OF ANY TYPE MAY BE PLACED IN CEMETERY

DO NOT RAISE OR MOUND GRAVES

SHEPHERDS HOOKS, METAL POSTS, CURBING OR FENCING OF ANY TYPE, BRICKS, STONES, OR MULCH ARE PROHIBITED

WINTER DECORATIONS MAY BE PLACED AFTER NOVEMBER 15 WITH THE PURCHASE OF A REMOVAL TAG, UNLESS YOU PLAN TO REMOVE DECORATION YOURSELF BY MARCH 15

WINTER DECORATIONS WILL BE REMOVED BY MARCH 15 WEATHER PERMITTING

ALL PROHIBITED ITEMS AND UNSIGHTLY FLOWERS AND PLANTINGS WILL BE REMOVED AND PLACED IN STORAGE FOR CUSTOMER PICK UP DURING OFFICE HOURS. ANY ITEMS LEFT OVER 90 DAYS WILL BE DISPOSED OF.
